- 1. The Host Club Officials reserve the right to reject or to disqualify any person, who interferes with the harmony of this tournament. ATA Rules will govern this tournament and all scores will be entered in the ATA official records. By entering these events, all shooters agree to accept official decisions and abide by the rules! Violating ATA or Host Club Safety Rules will be cause for disqualification and removal from the grounds!
- 2. CLASSIFICATION. All shooters must provide their paid ATA Average Card with all scores posted and averaged. Trapshooters must shoot their assigned Handicap Yardage or be disqualified. Previous and current averages plus "known ability" will be used to determine a shooter's proper Class for Singles and Doubles events and will be applied as follows:

3. TARGET REQUIREMENTS. <u>Target requirement must be met prior</u> to Friday, March 22, 2024. Registered ATA targets shot before the target requirement date may be used to achieve the minimum target requirements, but the burden is on each shooter to report for reclassification.

The penalty for all shooters not meeting the target requirement follows:

SINGLES PENALTY: Shooters with less than 1,000 Singles in the current and previous year must shoot in "Class A" or higher.

DOUBLES PENALTY: Shooters with <u>less than 500 Doubles</u> in the current and previous year must shoot in "Class A" or higher.

HANDICAP PENALTY*: Shooters with <u>less than 1,000 Handicap</u> targets in the current and previous year must shoot on the "*Twenty-three Yard Line*" or the current handicap yardage, whichever is greater, unless they shoot "*Targets Only.*"

TARGETS ONLY: Shooters who have been classified for "*Targets Only*" in Handicap events cannot play purses or options and they are not eligible for trophies, titles or added money!

*Shooters who are 70 or older are NOT penalized in handicap events. (See ATA rule XI, A.).

4. **SPECIAL CATEGORIES.** All Category Shooters must declare an **ATA special category** at the time of classification. It is the shooter's responsibility to verify the special category by checking the top of the paid receipt. No classification will be changed once the first shot of the tournament is fired unless target requirements are met according to tournament rule #4 above.

The Special Categories are:

Sub Junior (a shooter who has not reached his/her 15th birthday)

Junior (a shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th birthday)

Jr. Gold (a shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd birthday)

Lady II (a Female shooter who has reached her 55th birthday)

Sub-Veteran (a shooter who is 55 but has not reached his/her 65th birthday)

Veteran (a shooter who is 65 but has not reached his/her 70th birthday)

Sr. Veteran (a shooter who is 70 or older; no minimum target penalty)

FALL BACK. At all tournaments where All-American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one category. Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

Any shooter who is tied for <u>event Champion</u> may shoot-off/carry-over for the Championship trophy. If a shooter fails in the Championship trophy shoot-off/carry-over and has declared a special category at the time of classification, the shooter <u>can fall back to the declared category</u>.

Any shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and whose score qualifies for any trophy in his/her declared category, will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group. Any special category shooter, whose score does not qualify for a trophy in his/her category, may compete for place, class or yardage group trophies. Once any declarations have been made either by the shooter or by shoot management, the declaration is final and cannot be changed. There shall be no exceptions to this rule.

All Ladies, Sub Juniors, Junior Gold, Sub-Vets, Veterans, and all Sr. Veterans must declare their special category at classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter.

Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy for the duration of the tournament. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after his/her first shot. There will be no exceptions to this rule.

- 6. **PROOF OF RESIDENCY.** *Florida Residents* must present their paid ATA Average Card, with a *Florida* Address, to be eligible for resident titles, trophies, and added money! Adult *Florida Residents* must also show their valid *Florida Drivers License* or their *Florida Voter Registration Card* as proof of residency. No trapshooter may compete for Resident Trophies or **ATA Trophies**, unless for the immediately preceding six (6) months he/she has been a *bona fide resident* of the **State of Florida** and a member in good standing with the FTA. In case there is a dispute with respect to the residence of a shooter entering this tournament, it shall be the duty of the Classification Committee to rule on a shooter's right to compete as a *Florida Resident* and any such ruling shall be final! All complaints must be filed within 30 days of the last day of the shoot.
- 7. NON RESIDENTS. Non-Resident trophies are for NON-RESIDENT SHOOTERS ONLY. Resident Trophies are for FLORIDA residents only. All <u>FTA Added Money Is Guaranteed</u> and will be awarded with the trophy and title! Please collect your trophy and have your photograph taken for the Trap & Field magazine article. The FTA will not ship or mail your trophies!
- 8. **TOURNAMENT FEES.** In addition to the entry fee, all shooters must pay the daily ATA (\$3.00) and the FTA (\$3.00) fees. A Florida Hall of Fame Fee (\$.50) will be collected from all shooters when they enter the *Florida State Handicap Championship*. Only U.S. currency will be accepted! Entry fees cannot be refunded unless an event is canceled by Tournament Officials and/or the Host Club's Shoot Management! Entries will be closed when the last squad takes the line.
- 9. OPTIONS. Options and purses are <u>not compulsory</u> and may be played at the time of entry only! Changes or cancellations will not be allowed after your entry has been paid. Pay off sheets will be posted for all events by the Host Club's computer operators, who cannot be responsible for errors in your scores after the pay off sheets are posted. Please check your scores after each event!
- 10. **PURSE CALCULATIONS.** All *Lewis Purses* will be paid based on three (3) classes 60/40% and ties will divide. If less than 9 entries, the Lewis will be eliminated and refunded. All **Percentage Purses** will be paid 50/30/20 percentage system (ties will divide)! All **Class Purses** will be paid 60/40% and each class will shoot for its own money (ties will divide). When less than ten (10) shooters enter a purse or option, the purse or option will be eliminated and your money will be refunded!

- 11. SHOOTER RESPONSIBILITY. To prevent unnecessary delays, each shooter must be on the proper starting trap and ready to shoot. Squads <u>cannot</u> wait and must start within 3 (three) minutes of the previous squad. Shooters missing more than their first sub-event may be resquadded by shoot management and charged a \$10.00 resquad/makeup fee! Shooters may *make up one sub-event* on the practice trap. A shooter cannot re-squad by joining another squad on the line that has an open position.
- 12. **TRAP LOADS.** Only regulation ATA trap loads may be shot! Factory shells and reloads may be used; however, suspect shells will be subject to challenge by Tournament Officials. All violators will be disqualified. Keep your *gun unloaded* until you are on the line and it is *safe to shoot!* Test shots will not be permitted on the program trap fields. Please do not pick up empty hulls!
- 13. CARRY OVERS/SHOOTOFFS. In accordance with time constraints at the Silver Dollar, attempts will be made to complete shoot-offs not carried over. Ties in all Preliminary Events will carry over to the next like sub-event(s), except HANDICAP, which will be decided by shoot-off. Each shooter will be called to shoot off three (3) times. If the shooter does not report, he/she will forfeit the trophy and added money! Ties in Handicap may flip (if all shooters involved agree) or shoot-off. Should shoot-offs NOT be completed by the 7:45 PM deadline, the remaining shoot-offs will be decided by coin toss or carried to the next evenings handicap shoot-off.
- 14. CLASS ADVANCE. Beginning with Event 1, the high score in each Singles, Doubles Class will advance one class.
- 15. Shooters breaking *100 Straight or 200 Straight* without carry over will be awarded a Florida 100 Straight Pin or 200 Straight Pin by the ATA Delegate or FTA Secretary.
- 16. Voting for State Officials & By-Laws: FTA members in good standing are Florida residents longer than 6 months and are active members (e.g. having registered targets in Florida within the last 12 months).

Voting for ATA Delegate: Voting will be governed by the ATA rule book Section 1.

ATA HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTOR AWARD (LEWIS OPTION)

The \$20 fee for this award is a 50% tax-deductible donation to the ATA Hall of Fame. This donation provides support to our museum and to the many worthy projects undertaken by the Hall of Fame.

All donors will qualify for the Hall of Fame Award. Your entry card shows this contribution and is your receipt. The Hall of Fame will retain 50% of the donation while the remainder will constitute the portion to be awarded. Monies will be paid out in three Lewis Classes, 60/40 each class.

NOTE: Any ties will be resolved by shoot management's discretion.

Florida Resident Junior & Sub-Junior Shooters will be responsible for paying full price—all daily fees, target fees, and Florida Hall of Fame fees.

All the Target fees will be refunded by the FTA Secretary for the 400 Championship targets at the completion of the Florida State Shoot with valid FL State Shoot Account Statement.

Any Florida Resident Junior or Sub-Junior shooter participating in the F.T.A. Youth Target Program are ineligible to participate in any purse or option for any event, and may not participate in the special event. In order to be eligible for Youth trophies, participants must shoot all targets of the 400 Championship Targets (HAA).

No cash awards are available for Florida Junior and Florida Sub-Junior category shooters participating in the FTA Youth Target Program.

Failure to follow these policies strictly will result in disqualification.

- 1. The Sunshine State Gun Club Team Race will run concurrently with the Florida State Singles Championships. Only Florida Residents may enter and they MUST SHOW PROOF that they are members of the club for which they volunteer. FTA Gun Clubs may enter as many teams as desired, but their members are limited to only one Gun Club team! Team composition may be any class shooter and the advantage point system will apply. The team posting the highest total score (200 targets per shooter) will earn and receive individual awards. All teams must be entered before the event starts through the FTA Secretary, who will provide the entry forms for all team races.
- 2. The *Sunshine State Husband and Wife Team Race* will run concurrently with the *Florida State Singles Championships*. The Husband and Wife Team with the highest score including advantage points (400 targets total) will receive a team award. All team members must be **Florida Residents** and enter prior to the event starting through the **FTA Secretary**, who will provide entry forms for all teams.
- 3. The *Sunshine State Parent and Child Team Race* will run concurrently with the *Florida State Singles Championships*. One parent may enter with one of their children and the other parent may enter with a second sibling. The Parent and Child Team with the highest score including advantage points (400 targets total) will receive a team award. All team members must be **Florida Residents** and enter prior to the event starting through the **FTA Secretary**, who will provide entry forms for all teams.
- 4. The *Sunshine State Challenge Team Race* will run concurrently with the *Florida State Singles Championships*. Team members must coordinate their own teams and enter prior to the event starting through the **FTA Secretary**, who will provide entry forms. Each shooter is <u>limited to one Challenge team</u>. The team posting the highest combined scores (200 targets per shooter) will earn and receive individual awards. All team members must be **Florida Residents**. Each team may consist of any class shooter, who will be assessed the advantage points that are indicated below:

Class AA	0 advantage points plus score.
Class A	2 advantage points plus score.
Class B	4 advantage points plus score.
Class C	6 advantage points plus score.
Class D	8 advantage points plus score.

Winners of the team races will receive a team buckle.
