GENERAL INFORMATION

Classification, squadding & cashiering will utilize SOS Clays software. After classification, those presquadded may proceed directly to cashiering. Squadding will also be available throughout the day.

Singles & handicap events will be conducted over five banks of two adjacent traps. Doubles events will be conducted over 8 fields. Banks will not be randomized. Management reserves the right to use a 10-per-post system if attendance warrants.

NH Resident Juniors & Sub-Juniors may shoot for discounted rates (plus fees) in Event 4 when purses/options not played.

It is the shooter's responsibility to check scores on score sheets as well as the scoreboard. Once purses & options are figured, they will not be changed for scoreboard errors. Scores will be corrected for reporting purposes only.

Payoffs for Friday's events will be Saturday following the first 100. Payoffs for Saturday's event will be Sunday following the doubles championship. Payoffs for Sunday's events will be by check.

Resident runner-up in championship events (4, 5 & 6) will take precedent in class or yardage group for resident added money.

If shoot-offs cannot be held or must be terminated early, a winner will be determined by reverse long run. For HOA and HAA, total event score in reverse order will be used.

GENERAL INFORMATION (CONT.)

Management reserves the right to refuse entry, change the program, or adjust the traps any time as needed.

All entries are final. No changes or refunds unless significant extenuating circumstances exist.

A brief NHTA association meeting will be held immediately following the doubles championship to elect the ATA Delegate and Alternate Delegate(s).

Average cards must be up-to-date & correct, or shooters may be placed in AA.

(ATA Rules Govern)

PENALTY CLASSIFICATION

To avoid penalty classification, shooters must have at least **800 singles**, **500 handicap**, **and 400 doubles** targets registered in the current and previous target years combined.

Those not meeting the minimum target requirements are subject to the following penalty classifications:

SINGLES:

Class B or Higher (Based on Known Ability)

DOUBLES:

Class B or Higher (Based on Known Ability)

HANDICAP:

2 yards above ATA assigned yardage (subject to a 23-yard minimum and a 25yard maximum) for Adult Males, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran & Veteran shooters.

2 yards above ATA assigned yardage (subject to a 21-yard minimum and a 25yard maximum) for Lady I, Lady II, Junior & Sub-Junior shooters.

NO PENALTY YARDAGE ASSIGNED TO ANY SHOOTER WHO IS **70 YEARS OR OLDER**.

TARGETS ONLY

Participants may elect to shoot "Targets Only" to avoid handicap penalty yardage, but cannot play purses or options, and will be ineligible for trophies or added money.



SHOOT PIN INITIALS

The initials on this year's shoot pin are in honor of Lillian Chick and Charles Wright.

Lillian Chick, whose ATA shooting career spanned 38 years from 1970 to her last registered shoot in 2008, registered 30,775 singles, 17,400 handicap, and 14,100 doubles. Over the years she earned 19 NH Lady titles, and many Husband/Wife & Parent/Child trophies. Lillian owned Chick Embroidery with her husband Robert Chick Sr., and were staples of many New England Area State Shoots selling shooting apparel.

Charles M. Wright, a longtime resident of Southern New Hampshire, contributed greatly to our sport as a trap & skeet range owner & manager. He helped build and managed the Winchester Public Shooting Center in Nashua, NH for many years, and finished his career managing the Peninsula Sportsman's Club in Menlo Park, CA.



State teams from New England are invited to participate in the Granite State Cup. 5person teams compete in the All-Around program (Events 4,5, & 6) to be eligible.

Individual trophies will be awarded to each winning team member.
