GENERAL INFORMATION

SHELLS are available. Legal reloads permitted. If you want your empties, catch them. No one will be permitted to pick up empty hulls.

REFUNDS and ENTRIES: No entry fees, purses, or options will be refunded after the event has started. Also, no purses or options will be accepted after the first score sheet is posted.

AWARDS: Please notify handicappers at registration if you intend to shoot in a special category. You must shoot either class or category. No shooter may win more than one award per event.

SHOOT-OFFS: To the greatest extent possible, ties will be carried over, but if not they will be shot off. Shooters must be available or forfeit.

CONDUCT: The Great Falls Trap Club reserves the right to refuse entry or withdraw any contestant who in any way interferes with the safety, harmony and enjoyment of this shoot.

CLASS WINNERS: Winners will move up a class on next days shoot.

SAFETY FIRST

- 1. All guns must be unloaded, with action open, at all times, EXCEPT on the firing line or in a gun rack. Guns will not be shouldered in the clubhouse.
- No tracking of targets behind a shooting squad is permitted.
- 3. In singles shooting, only one shell may be inserted in the gun (for doubles, two shells) and only when on the firing line. No gun should contain a live shell, an empty shell, a snap cap or any similar device while the shooter is moving from station to station.
- As a safety precaution, test shots will not be permitted.
- Watch the muzzle, keep it pointed in a safe direction.
- Alcohol and drugs impair judgment and the ATA Rules pertaining to the usage of alcohol and/or drugs will be enforced by Shoot Management. All persons including competitors, referee/scorers, and trap personnel must wear appropriate eye and hearing protection while on the trap field. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.
- 7. The club management may disqualify a contestant for any violation of these rules.
- 8. By entering the competition every person agrees to accept all official decisions and to abide by the current ATA Rules.
